**Come Give Your Input on
Proposed Changes to Emanuel's Constitution
Next meeting Tuesday August 16th at 7PM**



This summer we are having meetings to discuss proposed changes to Emanuel's constitution.

Tuesday August 16th at 7PM in Jacobs Hall

Sunday August 21st at 11AM in Jacobs Hall

At these meetings we will be gathering input and crafting proposed changes to Emanuel's constitution.

There are two types of changes to the constitution that we will be considering:

- ELCA model constitution changes. The national church that Emanuel is part of requires member congregations to conform to the ELCA model constitution - chapters 2 - 9 and 15 - 19. These chapters of the constitution deal primarily with what we believe as a church and how the congregation interacts with the synod and national church. The plan is to call for a special congregational meeting on **Sunday November 6th** after worship to vote on adopting these model constitution changes.
- We will also be considering changes to the remaining chapters of Emanuel's constitution - chapter 10 - 14. We started this process at last year's annual meeting. A 2nd vote with a 2/3 majority is required to adopt those changes. That will happen at next year's annual meeting. We would also like to consider other changes to chapters 10 - 14. A preliminary review of these chapters showed inconsistencies in terms and how we actually function as a congregation.

Our goal is to make changes that will make Emanuel's constitution clear, understandable and realistically workable. Please consider joining us.

If you are NOT able to make these meetings, but would like to give input into this process, please email Pastor Todd with your thoughts and comments.

Upcoming Commemorations

Maximilian Kolbe, died 1941; Kaj Munk, died 1944; martyrs

Sunday, August 14, 2022

Father Kolbe was a Franciscan priest arrested by the Nazis and confined in Auschwitz. Kolbe gave generously of his meager resources, and finally volunteered to be starved to death in place of another man. A Danish Lutheran pastor and playwright, Munk strongly denounced the Nazis who occupied Denmark in the Second World War. His sermons and articles helped to show the anti-Christian nature of the movement.

Mary, Mother of Our Lord

Monday, August 15, 2022

The church (including Martin Luther) honored Mary with the title theotokos, meaning "God-bearer," for her role in giving birth to the Son of God. Her song, the Magnificat, speaks eloquently of God's lifting the lowly and feeding the hungry.

Bernard, Abbot of Clairvaux, died 1153

Saturday, August 20, 2022

Bernard, a Cistercian monk, was a man of great spirituality who wrote mystical works and criticized those whom he thought took an overly intellectual approach to the faith. He became an abbot, and wrote several hymns that are still beloved today.
