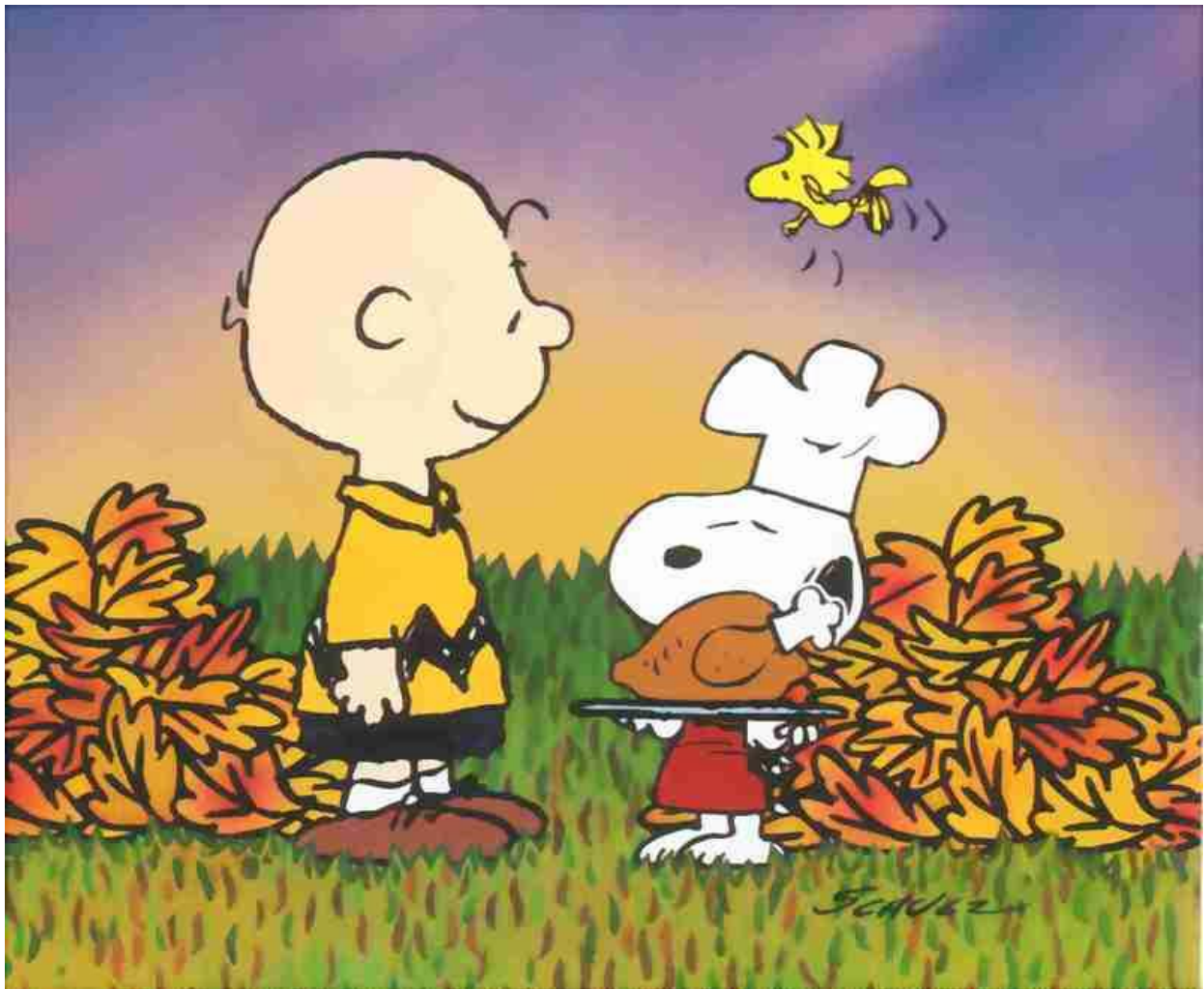

Special Congregational Meeting Results



On Sunday November 6th Emanuel had its special congregational meeting to consider adopting changes to Emanuel's constitution.

The changes considered were from the ELCA model constitution and were clauses that the ELCA requires all congregations to share in common.

The meeting was a short one. After an introduction by the pastor a motion was made to adopt the proposed changes. There was some discussion on whether or not we should wait until we can consider additional changes that were added to the ELCA model constitution this past August.

The motion passed 20 yes, 1 no. The changes were adopted. An updated version of Emanuel's constitution has been sent to the synod office to review and keep on file.

Upcoming Commemorations

Martin, Bishop of Tours, died 397

Friday, November 11, 2022

Martin's pagan father enlisted him in the Roman army. Approached by a beggar, Martin cut his cloak in half and gave part to the man, whom he later understood as representing Christ. He asked to leave the army, but was jailed instead. After his release, he became a preacher, and later a bishop.

Søren Aabye Kierkegaard, teacher, died 1855

Friday, November 11, 2022

Kierkegaard was a Danish theologian whose writings also gave rise to the modern philosophy of existentialism. He frequently attacked the complacency of the state church of his day, as well as its desire to be accepted by polite society rather than be a stumbling block.

Elizabeth of Hungary, renewer of society, died 1231

Thursday, November 17, 2022

Born in Hungary, Elizabeth was betrothed to the son of the Landgrave of Thuringia, and at age four was taken to be raised with him at the Wartburg Castle. Ten years later they were married. She was very generous to the poor, and after her husband's death she lived in cruel hardship until her own death at age twenty-four.
